**YOU MUST BE A REGISTERED PARTICIPANT TO CAMP!**

Well it's almost that time of year again and Back to the 50's camping staging is still on Wednesday, starting at **10AM**. Please don't arrive earlier. If you arrive before opening time on Wednesday, please find a place to park that is **NOT ON THE CITY'S STREETS**. **If you do park on the city's streets, you will be ticketed.**

Camping is \$30 per night, which is the same as last year. It is an additional \$5 per person, per night, if you have more than 6 persons on the campsite.

Only **ONE CAR** will be allowed for each campsite, whether it's your Rod or Custom or daily driver. There will be **No Exceptions**.

**ALL** others vehicles go to the overflow parking, across Hoyt.

**NO** awnings will be allowed, per rules. Easy-ups can be used, just not anchored down. A State Fair official may be working with us again this year, as they are the only ones licensed to run the campground.

**Back to the 50's Staging Area for the North Campgrounds**

Some changes and reminders this year for the staging process for North Campers. This year you will have to have your camper with you to receive a number in line for staging.

1. You need to be a registered participant, vendor or crafter to camp.
2. Before the staging process begins, PLEASE allow the staging crew to get set up before proceeding into the staging area.
3. For any newcomers, DOGS are not allowed in the staging area or the campgrounds.
4. Please have your Back to the 50's pre-registration letter and early workers cards for Thursday morning and Thursday early afternoon available when entering the staging drive up lines. That is the first thing we will be checking.
5. Campers, please stay with your car or camper until you receive your camping registration card (to be fill out legibly and completely) camping number, and arm bands.

If you are not present when we hand them out you will forfeit your number in line and receive higher number when you return.

6. Please drop off any car trailers or dollies before entering the staging area. Drop off lot is on Stella St, which is south of Como near MSRA Back to the 50's main gate #14 (Canfield St.).

7. Campers will not be able to get into the staging area until Wednesday morning approximately 9am.

8. Please be considerate of others and turn off generators by 10pm in staging area.

9. Staging gates will be closed at 10pm Wednesday and reopened approximately 8am Thursday morning.

10. Please keep all Fire Lanes open. Your vehicle must be parked ahead of or directly behind your camper.

11. No random parking in staging area. Any friends or relatives that may want to visit the staging area must park up by the front fence as you enter the staging area and walk back to meet you. Guests must leave by 10pm.

12. It is important to clean up your area before leaving the staging area.

13. There will be room for early South Campgrounds campers to stage.
