The Model Car Contest has returned to Back to the 50's for 2011. We are located under the Grandstand.

Friday, June 17, 9am – 6pm

Saturday, June 18, 9am – 6pm

Registration ends at 2pm so that the judges can do their work. The show resumes Sunday at 9am with the awards and drawing at 11am and the contest display will be open until 2pm. Modelers can pick up their models anytime before that.

We are excited to be working with Revell and having a Make & Take Contest for the youngsters. Getting young people to come into the hobby is very important for the future of MSRA and most of us got into this car thing starting with models. We have staff on hand to supervise the Make & Take contestants and parents are welcome to stay with their children but all construction must be done by the kids. These models will be judged separately and the kit being built will be a '34 Ford Street Rod.

Classifications for the rest of the contests are:

- A) Stock: Any car which is built to represent a factory stock vehicle. No modifications are allowed, other than those which are available from the factory. Kit mods such as converting a sedan to a convertible are acceptable provided the car remains stock.
- B) Street Rod: Any modified 1948 or earlier vehicle.
- C) Custom: Modified car or truck 1949 to 1964.
- D) Street Machine: 1965 to present, modified cars and trucks. All modifications are allowed, both body and performance.
- E) Competition: Any car or truck used primarily for organized racing, NOT street drivable.
- F) Truck: Recreational: includes 4X4s, pickups, vans, buggies. Commercial: Any vehicle used to produce revenue including fire and emergency vehicles and race haulers.
- G) Motorcycles: All two and three wheel vehicles.
- H) Box Stock: Any Model built EXACTLY from the kit. No modifications are allowed.
- I) Snap Kits: Open to Juniors only. Must be built from a snap kit with NO parental help. This class does not include the Make & Take Models.
- J) Dioramas: all
