In consideration of the acceptance of the right to participate and attend, entrant, participants, and/or spectators, by the execution of this liability release, forever release and discharge the Minnesota Street Rod Association and its officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives and servants, and anyone else connected with the management, presentation or promotion of the Minnesota Street Rod Association's annual "BACK TO THE 50's WEEKEND," and from any and all known or unknown damages, injuries, losses, judgments and/or claims, from any cause whatsoever that may be suffered by an entrant, participant and/or spectator to his or her person or property. Further, each entrant, participant and/or spectator, through the execution of this liability release, expressly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless all of the foregoing mentioned entities, firms, persons, bodies and/or organizations, of and from any and all liability occasioned or resulting from the conduct of entrant or any participant or entity assisting or co-operating with entrant and under the direction or control of entrant, participant and/or spectator. The undersigned, by and through the execution of this release form agrees, on behalf of any minor children that the undersigned and/or his or her spouse may bring to the event aforereferred to, that he or she has the authority to execute this agreement on behalf of said minor children and hereby agrees to the application of those terms as stated herein to said minor children, in their entirety. The undersigned and/or his or her spouse hereby further represent that he or she, by executing this release form, is acting both in his or her own individual capacity and, in addition thereto, in the capacity as the legal guardian of any minor child that the undersigned and/or his or her spouse may bring to the event.

OVERSIZED VEHICLES ACCEPTANCES & RESTRICTIONS

For purposes of defining vehicles for “MSRA Back to the 50’s Weekend” participation, the following classifications will be used as a common reference in determining acceptability and limitations on participation. **If you plan to bring an Oversized Vehicle to Back to the 50s, read the following information and check the box on the front of this form!**

- A. Commercial vehicle shall mean a vehicle having a commercial license plate.
- B. 1 ton = 2000 LBS.
- C. Truck / vehicle classifications shall be defined as follows:

All vehicles in this section must meet the same age, titling, insuring and registration requirements as standard regular participants.

Vehicles which are classified as Medium descriptive size as listed above (to class 5), which do not exceed 25 feet in length and which are not licensed as commercial vehicles will be considered for participation under the standard vehicle classification for full participation.

Persons with vehicles which fall into the classifications either over 25 feet in length or Class 6 and above are considered “Oversized Vehicles.” Oversized Vehicles will be allowed to participate in the event for 2011 with a specific area designated for their display which they are restricted to. Oversized vehicles will be provided with one gate and route for entrance and exit for the event as specified in the registration. Oversized vehicles will be identified as such by their unique participant window sticker. Oversized vehicles will not be allowed to be in areas other than those designated as their route and display area. Any oversized vehicles found outside of these areas will have their participant credentials pulled and be escorted from the fairgrounds.
